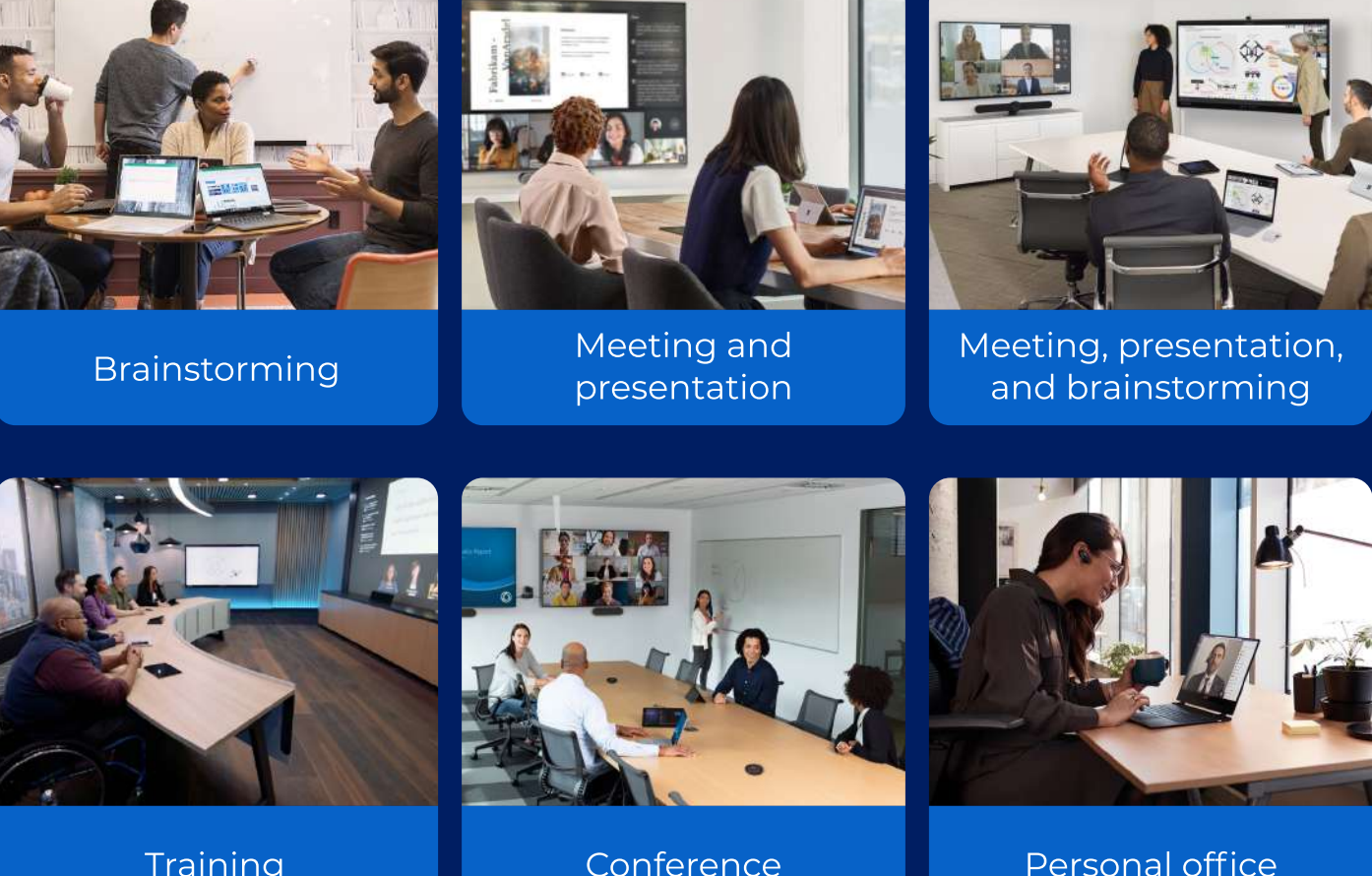
Here are four questions you can ask while selecting the technology for your next-gen meeting space.

1. What Is the Size of the Space?



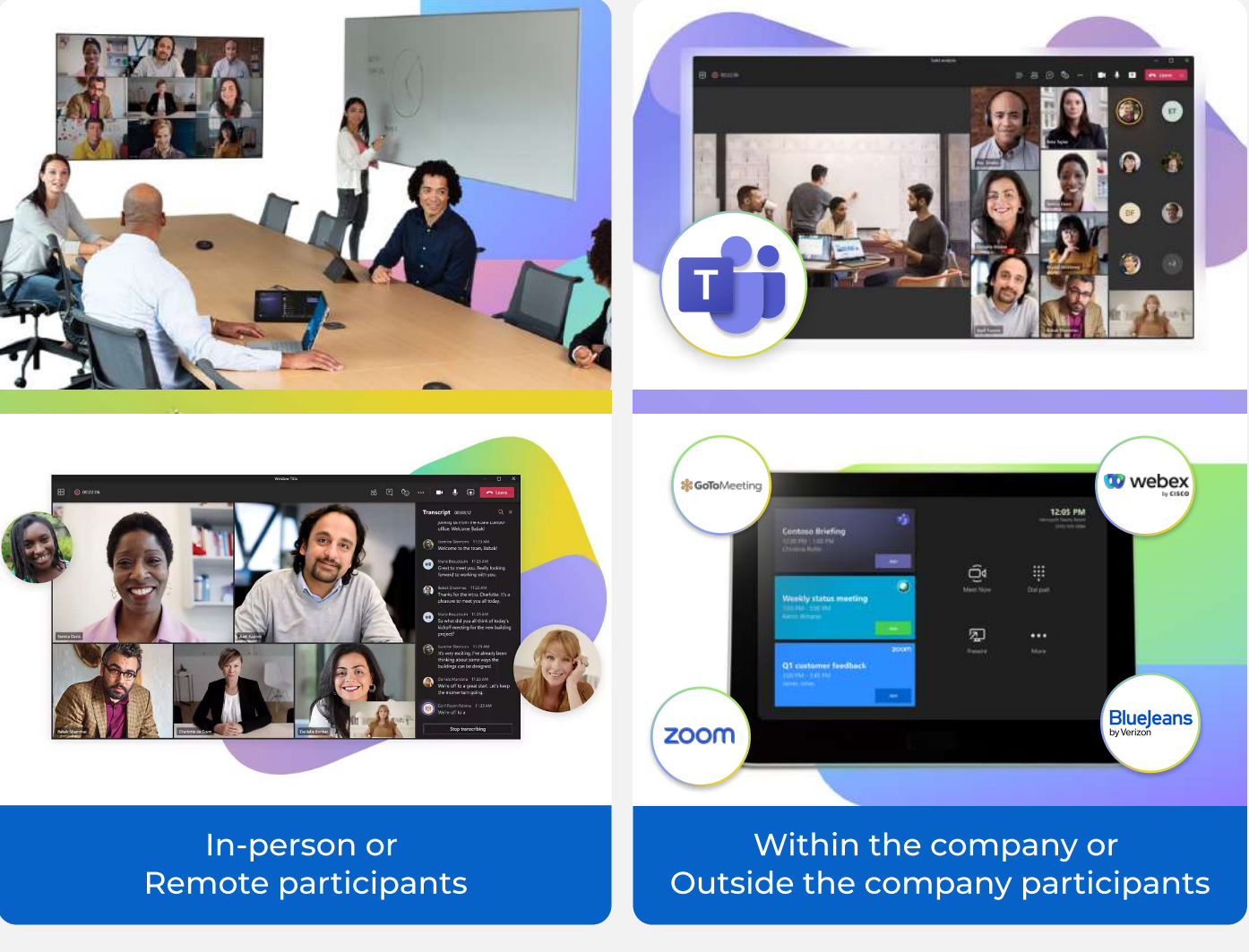
What to look for:
