42% of people report lower connection to colleagues is a key barrier of remote work




Companies are facilitating connection

See & be seen

Ensure all meeting participants have a clear, inclusive view of each other.

Make it possible for them to read the room and be aware of non-verbal communication, gesture, and expression



Immersive & inclusive

All three experiences combined create immersive and inclusive meetings



Hear & be heard

Ensure that audio is clear and enhances everyone's visual experience. Also, supply non-audio channels for people to communicate within the meetings such as chat



Enable collaboration

Provide ways to create and share content, both during and after the meeting. Make it easy for remote participants to take part in in-person collaboration activities



If an office is the 'glue', and processes and systems don't adapt for a remote workforce, remote team members will not feel included and will face constant communication barriers. This will make it harder for them to perform at the same level as their in-office peers.








Provides the same core functionality on both Windows and Android operating systems

Planning your meeting room upgrade?

You need a plan

Technology upgrades are just means to an end. Start with your key requirements and select the right technology and hardware depending on your budgets and other requirements

Get a baseline on current usage

What meeting spaces are in place now? How often are they used? Who are the key stakeholders for this room? Are the seats filled? What technologies are heavily used? What kinds of meetings are being held? Are there remote participants? etc.

Define existing commitments

Which devices have you already invested in? What is their lifecycle? What is their level of interoperability with the new solution?

Profile meeting rooms size and conditions

What is the size and purpose of the room – is it a huddle space, large conference room, or an executive office? What should be the dimensions and positioning of the screen? How much natural and artificial lightning is already there?

Determine how meeting rooms are and will be used

How would remote employees participate in the meeting? Is audio sufficient or would they need a full video and audio experience? Would they have to use screen sharing? Do you require a mobile experience or not? Simultaneously consider not just your current requirements but also your future ones.

Evaluate cost and ROI


